Thus, reality is developing at a pace that the law cannot always match. In consequence, there is a certain need to account for evolving circumstances within the framework of interpretation. The aim of this book is to review the consequences of this conflict for the interpretation of

ICL. How can the conflicting requirements be brought into balance? Can substantive rules of ICL be interpreted in a >dynamic< fashion to the detriment of the accused without violating the principle of legality? How do international criminal courts and tribunals deal with this issue?
